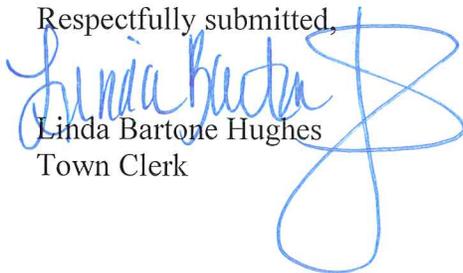
58 Res. AUTHORIZE ADJUSTMENT OF WATER BILL FOR JOHNATHAN HOYT
