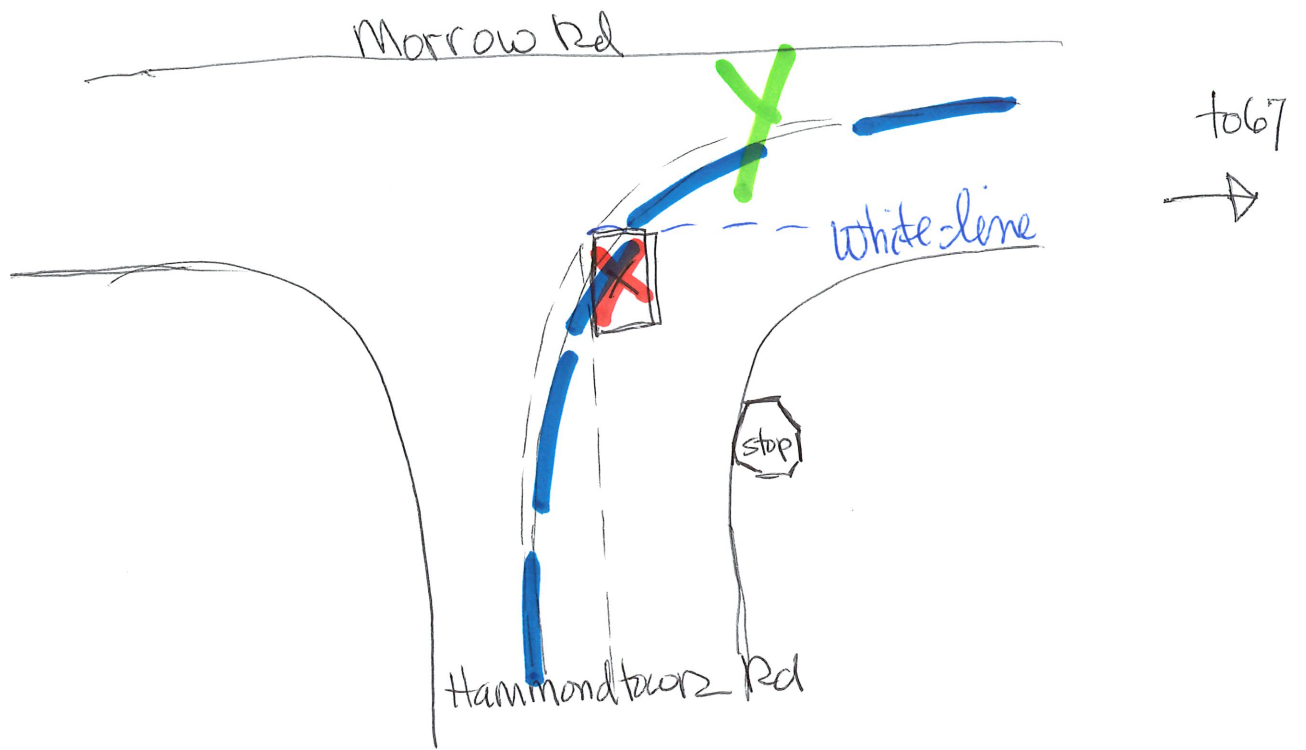
Ideas ① White lines where Vehicles should stop
